Elections: A motion to retain the current club officers for another year was voted on and approved with a unanimous vote.

New Transmitter Stand: Wes McCann is designing and will be building a new transmitter stand. All transmitters are required to be kept in the stand when not being used. The new stand will have an area for Spektrum users to display their Club and AMA cards. This will help keep track of who is a member and who is a visitor. Fliers using radios on 53MHz are required to use this area also.

New Toilet: A new portable toilet will be delivered as soon as the slab is poured for it

Helicopters: A pad for helicopters will also be poured this year.

Reminder -Field Access: It is required that we enter the field through the access road off Durham-Ferry. DO NOT enter through the farmer's entrance. Also, when entering the field the speed is not to exceed 10MPH. This is to reduce the amount of dust created and to try and minimize dust mites getting on the crops. If we don't adhere to these requirements it could potentially impact our ability to keep the field.
